"After servicing thousands of cisterns – poly or concrete, fed from a roof, or well – we have yet to find one that didn't benefit from our method," reports

Montgomery-Swan. "Dirt, algae, sludge, bird droppings, pollen and other unwanted contents such as worms, dead birds, mice and unidentifiable carcasses are removed to the relief of customers.

"And it is worth noting that water contamination with total coliforms and E-Coli can be fatal and must be physically removed from water!"

He also warns well-owners of iron, manganese, clay, and other deposits, advises those who have installed UV (ultra-violet) that residue from unclean water renders them ineffective, and that diverters only do part of the job.

Environmental Cistern Cleaning uses no chemicals, or cleaning agents and doesn't have to enter, or empty, the cistern, not only avoiding homeowner liability (and illegality) of 'confined space entry' legislation, but also wasting water. Only 50-100 gallons are required for cleaning, there is no down time and the cost to clean a 2,000 gallon is less than to fill it.
